“How can I contribute?” Fraternity Volunteerism

Practically every Wednesday and Sunday, I contribute my time to the Archdiocese of St. Louis singing bass for the Archdiocesan Choirs. The choirs sing masses, ordinations for priesthood & temporary/permanent deaconates, and the annual Christmas Concert. My parents were weekly contributors into the basket that they passed around every Sunday. But in my life, I found that it is easier for me to contribute my time versus money.

Tyler said it was after he attended a Business School Graduates/Actives lunch organized by the Alumni Association:

“Meeting many of the young actives and hearing their questions, helped me realize that as a now ‘old’ man of 30, I had a lot of good advice that I could give to our young brothers as they go through the college experience and prepare for life after college.

Additionally, it was really fantastic to begin to feel the sense of brotherhood that comes from being around fellow ADGs”

“[That] lunch helped me realize that I had a lot to give back to the Chapter that had given so much to me.”

Like many Alums, Tyler enjoys staying in contact with many of his Brothers from when he was an active. And also like many Alums, Tyler's post-graduate life put a lot of focus on career/personal life/ambitions and away from the Fraternity. Part of those ambitions included more volunteer work. And from that point, a new Chapter is about to start in the lives of Tyler and Beta Chapter.

The Fraternity and Education Foundation thrive (and survive) on similar stories of Fraternity Volunteerism. And, while becoming Ombudsman of a Chapter may be a deeper commitment that many alums avoid, attending U-Night or Laetare Sunday or Conferences or Conventions, even a quick lunch every semester or two or three with willing-to-learn Actives & Candidates, can be extraordinary experiences for both you and them.

This should have all your account profile information, order history, etc. If you do not see your name on AmazonSmiles go to "your profile" and input your email address that is currently linked to Amazon.com. Save this as your Amazon Favorite and use it as your portal from now on.
4. If you do not currently have an Amazon account simply set up your profile in AmazonSmiles when the opening page comes up after you hit "Start Shopping".
